10 EXPENSES AND GRANTS AND AID FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
11 HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF HEALTH
12 WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO
13 THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 2306 OF 2005; AND
14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - RURAL HEALTH FACILITIES. There is hereby
26 appropriated, to the Department of Health & Human Services - Division of
27 Health, to be payable from the Rural Health Services Revolving Fund, for
28 Grants and Aid for Rural Health Facilities of the Department of Health &
29 Human Services - Division of Health which shall be supplemental and in
30 addition to those funds appropriated in Act 2306 of 2005, the following:

1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES. There is hereby
2 appropriated, to the Department of Health & Human Services - Division of
3 Health, to be payable from the Emergency Medical Services Revolving Fund, for
4 Operating Expenses of the Department of Health & Human Services - Division of
5 Health which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
6 appropriated in Act 2306 of 2005, the following:

13 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - RURAL PHYSICIAN INCENTIVES. There is hereby
14 appropriated, to the Department of Health & Human Services - Division of
15 Health, to be payable from the Rural Physician Incentive Revolving Fund, for
16 Grants and Aid for Rural Physician Incentives of the Department of Health &
17 Human Services - Division of Health which shall be supplemental and in
18 addition to those funds appropriated in Act 2306 of 2005, the following:

25 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

35 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

1 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
2 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
3 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
5 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
6 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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8 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
9 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
10 the Department of Health & Human Services - Division of Health are, due to
11 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Health & Human
12 Services - Division of Health to continue to provide essential governmental
13 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies
14 for the Department of Health & Human Services - Division of Health to
15 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act
16 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
17 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
18 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
19 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
20 after the date of its passage and approval.

21 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
22 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
23 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
24 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
25 the veto.

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
