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       SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL. There
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    is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Building Authority, to be payable
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    from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for

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       SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
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    obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
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    described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
    therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
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    agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
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    donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
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    funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
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    Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
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    enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
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    otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
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    Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
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    not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
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       (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
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    Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
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    Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
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    and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
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    as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
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    funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.
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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
7	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
8	
9	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that previous
12	General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or
13	enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the
14	adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire,
15	the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the
16	citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.
17	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
18	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
19	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
20	passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the
21	Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time
22	during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the
23	Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date
24	the last house overrides the veto.
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
