13	AN ACT TO CREATE THE UAMS CANCER RESEARCH CENTER	
14	MATCHING FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17	AN ACT TO CREATE THE UAMS CANCER	
18	RESEARCH CENTER MATCHING FUND.

21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 12 is amended	l
24	to add an additional section to read as follows:	
25	19-5-1230. UAMS Cancer Research Center Matching Fund.	
26	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the	
27	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous	
28	fund to be known as the "UAMS Cancer Research Center Matching Fund".	
29	(b) The fund shall consist of such revenue as may be authorized by	
30	<u>law.</u>	
31	(c) The fund shall be used as matching funds for the construction of	
32	and endowments for the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences Cancer	
33	Research Center.	
34	(d)(1) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall release funds to	
35	the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences on a matching basis in an	
36	amount equal to the amount of grants and donations received as cash, cash	

1	equivalent, or an in-kind property pleage enforced by a binding written
2	agreement. The period for which grants and donations shall be counted for
3	matching purposes shall be January 1, 2007, through June 30, 2009.
4	(2) The release of the funds shall be upon documentation
5	demonstrating that the matching requirement has been met. The documentation
6	shall be signed by the Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical
7	Sciences.
8	(3) Requests for the release of funds may be made on a quarterly
9	basis, and pending a favorable review of the documentation by the Chief
10	Fiscal Officer of the State, payments shall be made in the first month
11	following the request.
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13	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14	Assembly that the effectiveness of this act on July 1, 2007, is essential
15	because an appropriation will be made for the fund created by this act and
16	the appropriation will become effective on July 1, 2007; and that a delay \underline{in}
17	the effective date of this act beyond July 1, 2007, could work irreparable
18	harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
19	programs. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
20	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and
21	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
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
