19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-20-104(b), regarding the required  
22 standard equipment for motorcycles, is amended to read as follows:

23 (b) All passengers and operators of motorcycles, motor-driven cycles,  
24 and motorized bicycles used upon the public streets and highways of this  
25 state shall be equipped with and shall wear the following equipment under  
26 standards set forth by the Office of Motor Vehicle:

27 (1) Protective headgear ~~unless the person is twenty-one (21)~~  
28 ~~years of age or older~~; and

29 (2) Protective glasses, goggles, or transparent face shields.
