30	(A) That is unused may not be carried over to the next		
31	calendar year; and		
32	(B) Is not compensable to the state employee at the time		
33	of retirement.

35	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
36	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act adds to the		

1	provisions of the Uniform Attendance and Leave Policy Act and that the ideal		
2	time to implement this change to the state's leave policies is at the		
3	beginning of the state's fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
4	exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace,		
5	health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2007.
