1 2 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 4 FAYETTEVILLE VETERANS' HOME. Before funds or appropriations for the 5 Fayetteville Nursing Home are spent, the Department of Veterans' Affairs 6 shall present to the Joint Budget Committee or the Arkansas Legislative 7 Council, a detailed report of the proposed project and a revised budget for 8 operation showing there are sufficient funds for the entire operation. No 9 funds shall be expended on construction or renovation of the Fayetteville 10 Nursing Home until there is a balanced operating budget presented to the 11 Joint Budget Committee or the Arkansas Legislative Council showing no 12 additional general revenue will be needed for the operation of the home. 13 14 Before any additional expenditures for the 2004 - 2005 2007 - 2008 fiscal 15 year are spent, the Department of Veterans' Affairs shall present to the 16 Joint Budget Committee or the Arkansas Legislative Council, a detailed report 17 of the proposed project and a revised budget for operation of the Nursing 18 Home. 19 20 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRAINING 22 CONFERENCES. The funds appropriated herein for Aid to County Veterans Service 2.3 Offices may also be used by the Department of Veteran Affairs to pay expenses 24 of County Veterans Service Officers for attending regional or statewide 25 training conferences approved by the Department of Veterans Affairs and 26 designed to provide better trained and qualified Veterans Service Officers in 27 the various counties. Any such expenses paid by the Department of Veterans 28 Affairs from funds appropriated herein shall be on the same reimbursement 29 basis as the reimbursement of state employees for expenses incurred in 30 attending their official business. Provided, no County Veterans Service Officer shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for expenses incurred in 31 32 attending more than two (2) approved conferences per year, per county. The 33 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2007 34 through June 30, 2007 2009.

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SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 3 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 9 10 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18 19 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 21 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 24 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 25 26 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 27 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 28 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
