27	(1) Has separated from service of any kind in the Arkansas	
28	National Guard or armed forces reserve;	
29	(1)(2) The member pays for all of the Pays for the year of	
30	service in the Arkansas National Guard or in the armed forces reserve, or	a
31	portion of the service in one-year increments, at one (1) time in a single	
32	lump-sum payment; and

36	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-2-503(f), concerning certain details	of

- the Arkansas National Guard and armed forces reserve service credit, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (f)(1) This section is supplemental to § 24-2-502, and nothing in this 4 section shall diminish the right of any member of the system to obtain 5 credited service in the system for active duty military service within the 6 limits permitted by § 24-2-502.
- 7 (2) However, no member is entitled to receive more than one (1) 8 year of credited service rendered by the member under this section.
- 9 (3) No member is eligible to purchase service credit in more 10 than one (1) state-supported retirement system for service time in the 11 Arkansas National Guard or in the armed forces reserve.
- 12 (4) Service credit in the system for active duty military
 13 service under § 24-2-502 and for service in the Arkansas National Guard or in
 14 the armed forces reserve shall not be given for the same period of time.
- 15 (5) The service is not credited as service A member's service in

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-4-101(29), concerning the definition of "participating public employer", is amended to read as follows:
 - (29) "Participating public employer" means:
- 23 (A) Any county, municipality, rural waterworks facilities
 24 board, regional airport authority, public facilities board, regional solid
 25 waste management board, joint county and municipal sanitation authority,
 26 <u>suburban improvement district under § 14-92-502</u>, or regional water
 27 distribution board in the state whose employees are included in the
 28 membership of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System;

- SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-4-301(c), concerning municipal employees eligible to join the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, is amended to read as follows:
- 33 (c) All municipal employees, as defined in § 24-4-101(17), (24), and
 34 (27) who are in the employ of a municipality as of the date the municipality
 35 becomes a participating public employer and all persons who become municipal

Arkansas Code § 24-4-1102(b)(2), concerning member 22 contributions to the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, is amended 23 to read as follows: 24 (2)(A) Member contributions picked up by the employer shall be 25 paid from the same source of funds used for the payment of salary to a 26 member. 27 (B) The employer shall be solely responsible for remitting 28 member contributions to the system in a manner consistent with § 24-4-202, 29 including without limitation compliance with deadlines and penalties. 30 (B)(C) A deduction shall be made from each member's salary equal to the amount of the member's contribution picked up by the employer. 31 32 (C)(D) For all other purposes, member contributions picked 33 up by the employer shall be considered member contributions. 34 35 36
