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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - CANCER RESEARCH CENTER CONSTRUCTION AND
27 ENDOWMENT MATCHING. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of
28 Arkansas for Medical Sciences, to be payable from the UAMS Cancer Research
29 Center Matching Fund, for matching funds for construction and endowments, as
30 released by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State upon favorable review of
31 documentation, of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for the
32 biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the sum of.....\$50,000,000
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34 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
36 TRANSFER. Upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of



1 the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer
 2 and the Auditor of the State the sum of fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000)
 3 from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the UAMS Cancer Research
 4 Center Matching Fund to provide funds for the appropriation provided herein.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
 6 through June 30, 2009.

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 8 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 10 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
 14 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 15 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 16 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 17 with in disbursement of said funds.

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 19 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 28 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
 31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 34 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
 35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 36 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

1 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.

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
