SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas State Medical Board for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - MEDICAL BOARD. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Medical Board, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas State Medical Board, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas State Medical Board for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

14 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

16 EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS. The State Medical Board is hereby authorized to expend

17 from monies authorized herein, no more than \$200,000 each fiscal year for

educational programs, either public or private, for impaired physicians with

alcohol or drug abuse problems. The provisions of this section shall be in

20 effect only from July 1, 2005 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009.

- 22 SECTION 5. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
- 23 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DIRECTOR QUALIFICATIONS AND
- 24 <u>LIMITATIONS</u>. The Director of the State Medical Board shall:
- 25 <u>(a) have been in full-time clinical practice of medicine in direct patient</u>
- 26 care within one (1) year of filling the position of Medical Director;
- 27 (b) have fifteen (15) years of current continuous full-time medical service
- 28 immediately prior to the date of appointment which shall include, but not be
- 29 limited to, at least ten (10) years of full-time clinical practice in direct
- 30 patient care, five (5) years of which shall have been in full-time clinical
- 31 practice in direct patient care in the State of Arkansas;
- 32 (c) have not served on the Arkansas State Medical Board within the past five
- 33 (5) years; and
- 34 (d) have a comprehensive knowledge of the contemporary, broad-based clinical
- 35 practice of medicine with experience in direct patient care.

1	SECTION 6 . COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
2	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
3	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
4	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
5	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
6	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
7	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
8	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
9	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

11	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
12	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
13	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
14	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
15	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
16	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
17	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
18	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
19	
20	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
21	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
22	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
23	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
24	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
25	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
26	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
27	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
28	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
29	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
30	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
