11 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 13 DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS. Funding provided in Section 1 and 2 of this Act from the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund shall not be distributed unless there are 14 15 sufficient funds in the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund as of the date that 16 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State certifies the amount in excess of the 17 required reimbursement to the counties as provided in §26-26-310(b)(2)(C)(i). If there are sufficient funds remaining in the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund 18 on December 31, 2007 and December 31, 2008, as certified, the Treasurer shall 19 distribute four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to counties and four million 20 dollars (\$4,000,000) to cities for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 from 21 22 the balance remaining on December 31, 2007 and four million dollars 23 (\$4,000,000) to counties and four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to cities for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 from the balance remaining on December 24 31, 2008 from the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund. 32 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. 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6 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 8 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 10 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 13 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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15 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 16 17 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 19 20 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 21 22 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 23 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 24 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 25 26 27 */s/ Joint Budget Committee* 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
