5 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY 7 FAIR GRANTS. The Department of Rural Services shall develop the necessary 8 rules and regulations for the disbursement of matching fund grants to county 9 fairs for the construction, renovation and/or improvements to county fair 10 grounds. of new or replacement buildings. The grants shall be matched on a 11 50/50 basis. The match may be cash or in-kind. No county fair shall receive 12 more than \$30,000 for the biennium.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2005}{14}$ 14 $\frac{2007}{14}$ through June 30, $\frac{2007}{2009}$.

16 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANT 18 AWARD CRITERIA. The Department of Rural Services shall promulgate regulations 19 establishing the criteria to be utilized in determining to whom grants will 20 be made under this Act. Subject to the approval of the Governor, and after 21 prior review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint 22 Budget Committee, the Department of Rural Services shall distribute the 23 grants.

24 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of

25 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year

26 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by

27 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

28 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by

29 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly

30 has determined that the Department of Rural Services may operate more

31 <u>efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Rural</u>

32 Services authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both

33 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by

34 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee

35 <u>as provided by this section</u>. The requirement of approval by the Legislative

36 <u>Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.</u>

1 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget

2 <u>Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction</u>,

3 this entire section is void.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2007
5 through June 30, 2007 2009.

7 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 8 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 9 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 13 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

17 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 18 19 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 20 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 21 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 23 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 24 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

26 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 28 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 32 33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 34 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 35 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 36
