## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 6-17-114
CONCERNING TEACHER PLANNING PERIODS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114 is amended to read as follows: 6-17-114. Daily planning period.
(a) (1) Effective beginning the 2003-2004 school year, each Each school district in this state shall provide a minimum of two hundred (200) minutes each week for each teacher to schedule time for conferences, instructional planning, and preparation for all classroom teachers employed by the district.
(2) (A) The planning time shall be in increments blocks of no less than forty (40) thirty (30) minutes during the student instructional day unless a teacher submits a written request to be allowed to have his or her planning time scheduled at some time other than during the student instructional day.
(B) A teacher who does not receive the planning time required under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section during the student instructional day shall be compensated at his or her hourly rate of pay for each missed planning period except for planning periods missed because of:
(i) Scheduled meetings with the school principal of not more than one (1) time per week;
(ii) eccasional Occasional, not regularly scheduled

field trips,; or

(iii) fire drills, or bomb scares Drills or
evacuations for fire or other security or safety alarms.
(C) A school district shall be exempt from the provisions of this subdivision (a)(2) if it has collectively negotiated a contract through a local teachers' association and the collectively negotiated contract expressly provides for a teacher's daily planning period.
(b) (1) No school district shall provide planning time as required by this section by lengthening the school day unless the district compensates teachers for the additional time at an hourly per diem rate.
(2) Any teacher not receiving individual planning time as
provided for in this section shall be compensated for the planning time lost at his or her hourly rate of pay.
(c) Each school district shall implement the requirements of this section in accordance with § 6-17-201 et seq.
(d) As used in this section, "student instructional day" means the time that students are required to be present at school.
