10 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. 29 SECTION 3. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in 30 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment 31 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in 32 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the 33 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the 34 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall 35 determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the 36

agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend
monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:
(1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such
agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

5 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the 6 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

7 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the 8 employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with 9 respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such 10 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and 11 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes. 12

13 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 16 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 18 19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

22

23 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 24 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 25 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 26 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 27 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 30 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

32 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

33 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

34 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the

35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of

36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
2	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
3	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
4	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
5	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
6	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
