2	criterion set by this bill to determine those applicants qualified to take
3	next July's examination. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and
4	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
5	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
6	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
7	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
8	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
9	bill; or
10	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
11	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
