14 AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 1366 OF 2003,  
15 CONCERNING HOMELAND SECURITY AND THREAT

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Uncodified Section 4 of Act 1366 of 2003, as amended by Act  
22 1823 of 2005, concerning homeland security and threat assessment plans, is  
23 amended to read as follows:

24 Section 4. Sunset Clause.

25 This act expires on July 1, ~~2007~~ 2009.  
26

27 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
28 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 1366 of 2003, as amended,  
29 known as the Homeland Security Information Act, is necessary for the safety  
30 and protection of the citizens of the State of Arkansas; that without  
31 legislative action the Homeland Security Information Act will expire on July  
32 1, 2007; and that this act is immediately necessary to prevent the expiration  
33 of the act. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being  
34 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and  
35 safety shall become effective on:

36 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;



1                   (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,  
2 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the  
3 bill; or

4                   (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
5 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
