13 AN ACT TO CREATE THE ARKANSAS
14 LEGISLATIVE TASK FORCE ON CRITERIA AND
15 QUALIFICATIONS FOR CHIEFS OF POLICE.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE – DO NOT CODIFY.

22 (a) There is created the Arkansas Legislative Task Force on Criteria
23 and Qualifications for Chiefs of Police.

24 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:

25 (1) One (1) individual appointed by the Governor;

26 (2) One (1) member of the Senate appointed by the President Pro
27 Tempore of the Senate;

28 (3) One (1) member of the House of Representatives appointed by
29 the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

30 (4) One (1) individual appointed by the Attorney General;

31 (5) One (1) individual appointed by the Arkansas Municipal
32 League;

33 (6) One (1) individual appointed by the Arkansas Commission on
34 Law Enforcement Standards and Training;

35 (7) One (1) individual representing the Criminal Justice
36 Institute;



1 (8) One (1) professor of criminal justice appointed by the
2 Arkansas Association of Chiefs of Police; and

3 (9) The President of the Arkansas Association of Chiefs of
4 Police or his or her designee.

5 (c)(1) The members of the House of Representatives and Senate
6 appointed to the task force pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall
7 serve as co-chairs of the task force.

8 (2) Meetings of the task force shall be held at least one (1)
9 time every three (3) months, but may occur more often at the call of the
10 co-chairs.

11 (3) The task force shall conduct its meeting in Pulaski County
12 at the State Capitol.

13 (d) If any vacancy occurs on the task force, the vacancy shall be
14 filled by the same process as the original appointment.

15 (e) The task force shall establish rules and procedures for conducting
16 its business.

17 (f) Legislative members of the task force shall be entitled to receive
18 reimbursement for expenses and per diem at the same rate and from the same
19 source as provided by law for members of the General Assembly attending
20 meetings of interim committees.

21 (g) A majority of the members of the task force shall constitute a
22 quorum for transacting any business of the task force.

23 (h) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff for the
24 task force.

25 (i) The task force shall be abolished on January 15, 2009.

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27 SECTION 2. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE – DO NOT CODIFY. (a) The Arkansas
28 Legislative Task Force on Criteria and Qualifications for Chiefs of Police
29 shall examine the criteria and qualifications for a chief of police in the
30 State of Arkansas and recommend any revisions or additions to those criteria
31 and qualifications.

32 (b) On January 15, 2009, the task force shall deliver a report
33 containing the conclusions of the task force and any recommended revisions or
34 additions to the criteria and qualifications for a chief of police to:

35 (1) The Judiciary Committees of the House of Representatives and
36 Senate of the Eighty-seventh (87th) General Assembly;

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(2) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and
(3) The Speaker of the House.
