8	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
9	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the amount of legislative		
10	expense reimbursement, in lieu of per diem payments, and compensation for		
11	chairs and cochairs has not been updated in several years; that this act		
12	adjusts the payments for inflation factors; and that this act is immediately		
13	necessary in order to provide payments at the corrected amounts. Therefore,		
14	an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the		
15	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
16	on:		
17	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
18	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
19	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
20	bill; or		
21	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
22	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
