# A Bill

SENATE BILL 786

## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO REMOVE THE LICENSURE REQUIREMENT FOR  
10 FLIGHT INSTRUCTORS AND FLIGHT SCHOOLS LICENSED  
11 UNDER APPROPRIATE FEDERAL AVIATION AUTHORITY  
12 REGULATIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO REMOVE THE LICENSURE REQUIREMENT FOR  
16 FLIGHT INSTRUCTORS AND FLIGHT SCHOOLS  
17 LICENSED UNDER APPROPRIATE FEDERAL  
18 AVIATION AUTHORITY REGULATIONS.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-51-602(11)(B), concerning one (1) of the  
24 definitions of a "school" regulated by the State Board of Career Private  
25 Education, is amended to read as follows:

26 (B) "School" also means any firm, partnership,  
27 association, corporation, or other form of business organization which offers  
28 instruction in ~~flight or ground school to student fliers or~~ airframe or power  
29 plant mechanics;

31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-51-603(9), concerning exemptions to the  
32 licensing requirements of the State Board of Career Private Education, is  
33 amended to read as follows:

34 (9) Flight instructors, schools, or flight instructors and  
35 schools licensed under appropriate Federal Aviation Administration  
36 regulations and offering ~~only~~ training for a ~~private~~ pilot's license;
