17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Tire
20 Safety Act of 2007".
21

22 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 37, Subchapter 4 is amended
23 to add an additional section to read as follows:

24 27-37-403. Tire safety.

25 (a) No person shall sell, offer for sale, or have in his or her
26 possession with the intent to sell a tire for use on any automobile or Class
27 One truck or van as described in § 27-14-601 if the tire has been marked
28 "blem", "second", "imperfect", or any similar appropriate descriptive term.

29 (b) A violation of this section is a Class B misdemeanor.
