21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-904(b), concerning personal
24 reimbursement to state employees, is amended to read as follows:

25 (b)(1) Personal reimbursement will not be allowed to any state
26 official, state employee, or any other person traveling on official business
27 for expenses covering personal entertainment, ~~tips~~, flowers, valet service,
28 laundry and cleaning, or other personal expenses, as those expenses shall be
29 defined in the state travel regulations. All such persons shall be required
30 to submit their travel reimbursement requests upon forms prescribed by the
31 Department of Finance and Administration, itemized in such details as shall
32 be necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this section.

33 (2) The tip reimbursement amount shall not exceed fifteen
34 percent (15%) of the meal amount expended.

35 (3) The total reimbursement for meals and tips shall not exceed
36 the maximum rates prescribed by the Arkansas Financial Management Guide
