## Subtitle

AN ACT TO ALLOW FOR PERSONAL
REIMBURSEMENT TO STATE EMPLOYEES FOR THE PAYMENT OF TIPS WHILE TRAVELING ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-904(b), concerning personal reimbursement to state employees, is amended to read as follows:
(b) (l) Personal reimbursement will not be allowed to any state official, state employee, or any other person traveling on official business for expenses covering personal entertainment, tips, flowers, valet service, laundry and cleaning, or other personal expenses, as those expenses shall be defined in the state travel regulations. All such persons shall be required to submit their travel reimbursement requests upon forms prescribed by the Department of Finance and Administration, itemized in such details as shall be necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this section.
(2) The tip reimbursement amount shall not exceed fifteen percent (15\%) of the meal amount expended.
(3) The total reimbursement for meals and tips shall not exceed the maximum rates prescribed by the Arkansas Financial Management Guide
