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SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-4-1801 is amended to read as follows: 19-4-1801. Reimbursements and refunds generally.

(a) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall prescribe the method of handling refunds and reimbursements to the state for moneys previously paid out or due the state. If no properly classified appropriation account exists on the books of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and Auditor of State for which the respective refund is applicable, the director is authorized to establish such appropriation account on the books of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, Auditor of State, and various fiscal officers.

(b) No such refunds shall cause a transfer of appropriation on the
books of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, Auditor of State, and various
fiscal officers except for:
