EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 23 24 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that new scholarships under the Arkansas Governor's schola<u>rship program need to be awarded to students</u> 25 26 graduating in May of 2007; that the Department of Higher Education needs 27 sufficient time to solicit and receive scholarship applications; and that 28 this act is immediately necessary to ensure the proper administration of the 29 scholarship program. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this 30 act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and 31 safety shall become effective on: 32 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 33 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 34 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the 35 bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
