6	(c) An applicant whose family includes three
7	(3) or more unemancipated children shall have \underline{an} average family adjusted
8	gross income over the previous two (2) years not exceeding seventy thousand
9	dollars (\$70,000) eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) per year at the time of
10	application to the program, plus for families with more than three (3)
11	unemancipated children, an additional five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per year
12	for each additional child; and
13	(d) Any applicant whose family includes more
14	than one (1) unemancipated child enrolled full time at an approved
15	institution of higher education shall be entitled to an additional ten
16	thousand dollars (\$10,000) of adjusted gross income for each additional
17	unemancipated child enrolled full time at an approved institution of higher
18	education when the Department of Higher Education calculates financial need.

20	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
21	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the financial eligibility
22	requirements for the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program must be
23	clarified; that clarification of the eligibility requirements for financial
24	need will help more Arkansas students enter and complete their post-secondary
25	education; and that this act is immediately necessary to prevent student
26	hardships and provide stability for the 2007-2008 school year. Therefore, an
27	emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for
28	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
29	effective on:
30	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
31	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
32	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
33	bill; or
34	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
35	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
