## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE ARKANSAS TRAVELING  
TEACHER PROGRAM TO ASSIST RURAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS  
IN PROVIDING APPROPRIATELY CERTIFIED LICENSED  
TEACHERS TO TEACH REQUIRED COURSES IN  
KINDERGARTEN AND GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE (9-  
12); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE ARKANSAS  
TRAVELING TEACHER PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to establish the Arkansas  
Traveling Teacher Program to assist rural school districts in providing  
appropriately certified licensed teachers to teach required courses in  
kindergarten and in grades nine through twelve (9-12).
