19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-18-303(b)(14), concerning disclosure
22 from corporate franchise tax reports, is amended to read as follows:

23 (14) (A) Disclosure of the following information from corporate
24 franchise tax reports:

25 ~~(A)~~ (i) The name and address of the corporation;

26 ~~(B)~~ (ii) The name of the corporation's president, vice
27 president, secretary, treasurer, and controller;

28 ~~(C)~~ (iii) The total authorized capital stock with par
29 value;

30 ~~(D)~~ (iv) The total issued and outstanding capital stock
31 with par value; and

32 ~~(E)~~ (v) The state of incorporation;

33 (B) In the case of a franchise tax report filed by an
34 organization formed under the Small Business Entity Tax Pass Through Act, §
35 4-32-101 et seq., the confidentiality provision of subsection (a) shall apply
36 to the names of members of the organization, except those designated in the



1 organization's franchise tax report as a manager, president, vice-president,
 2 secretary, treasurer, or controller of the organization.

 4 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 26-54-105(h), concerning information in a
 5 franchise tax report, is amended to read as follows:

6 (h)(1) All information contained in a franchise tax report shall be
 7 confidential and not available for public inspection, except for the
 8 following:

9 ~~(1)~~(A) The name and address of the corporation;

10 ~~(2)~~(B) The name of the corporation's president, vice president,
 11 secretary, treasurer, and controller;

12 ~~(3)~~(C) The total authorized capital stock with par value;

13 ~~(4)~~(D) The total issued and outstanding capital stock with par
 14 value; and

15 ~~(5)~~(E) The state of incorporation.

16 (2) In the case of a franchise tax report filed by an
 17 organization formed under the Small Business Equity Tax Pass Through Act, §
 18 4-32-101 et seq., the names of members, except those designated in the
 19 organizations' franchise tax report as a manager, president, vice-president
 20 secretary, treasurer, or controller of the organization shall be confidential
 21 and not available for public inspection.

 23 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 24 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act concerns the
 25 disclosure of certain information in corporate franchise tax reports; that
 26 the release of this information to the public at large is harmful to the
 27 report's filer; and that this act should become effective as soon as possible
 28 to prevent this harm. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this
 29 act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and
 30 safety shall become effective on:

31 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

32 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
 33 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
 34 bill; or

35 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
 36 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
