Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE GUIDELINES FOR HEALTHY VENDING BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 7 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-18-708. Vending beverage guidelines.
(a) This section is intended to provide guidelines for public schools
in providing healthy vending beverage choices for public school students during the regular and extended school day.
(b) Each public school in this state is authorized to and shall
develop a policy concerning the dispensing of vending beverages on school grounds that include, at a minimum, the following:
(1) For public school students enrolled in grades six through nine (6-9), vending beverages may only include:
(A) Bottled water;
(B) (i) Low fat and nonfat regular and flavored milk and nutritionally equivalent milk alternatives, including without limitation, soy milk in serving sizes of ten (10) ounces or less that contain one hundred fifty (150) or fewer calories per eight (8) ounces.
(ii) Subdivision (b) (l) (B) (i) shall apply to soy

milk beginning July 1, 2008; and
    (C) One hundred percent (100%) fruit juices with no added
sweeteners in serving sizes of ten (10) ounces or less that contain:
    (i) One hundred twenty (120) or fewer calories per
eight (8) ounces; and
                    (ii) At least ten percent (10%) of the recommended
daily value for three (3) or more vitamins and minerals; and
    (2) A public school district shall include in its vending
beverage policy:
            (A) Whether and when vending beverages may be sold:
                    (i) On school grounds during the regular school day;
and
                    (ii) On school grounds during the extended school
day, including, without limitation, club activities, drama, band and choir
practice, student government activities, or other extracurricular and after-
school programs; and
                            (B) The time periods during the regular or extended school
day that vending beverages may be sold.
                    (C) The vending beverage policy developed by a public
school district under this section shall be reviewed by the Child Health
Advisory Committee or its designee.
