22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-21-206(7) and (9), concerning the powers
25 of duties of the state surveyor, is amended to read as follows:

26 (7) To:

27 (A) Prescribe reasonable rules and regulations not
28 inconsistent with law designed to establish uniform professional surveying
29 and mapping methods and standards in this state;

30 (B) Disseminate the rules and regulations to those engaged
31 in the profession of land surveying; and

32 (C) ~~Administer the regulations by referring evidence of~~
33 ~~violations to the Arkansas State Board of Registration for Professional~~
34 ~~Engineers and Land Surveyors as provided in subdivision (9) of this section~~
35 To receive and refer any complaint against a surveyor to the Arkansas State
36 Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors which



1 shall have the authority to investigate complaints and to determine the
2 appropriate action, if any;

3 (8) To promote the training and the increase in number of
4 quality surveyors in this state;

5 ~~(9) To receive and investigate complaints against any surveyor~~
6 ~~and to present the results from the investigation of complaints to the board~~
7 ~~for such action as the board shall deem appropriate;~~

8 ~~(10)~~ To assist the county assessors in establishing accurate
9 land descriptions of the state-owned or state-claimed lands and to assist the
10 public and private surveyors to obtain land ownership information for
11 surveying purposes;

12 ~~(11)~~(10) To accept for the state gifts, grants, and donations
13 from any and all persons, corporations, associations, and foundations and
14 from the federal or state government or any agency or program thereof to be
15 deposited in a financial institution in this state;

16 ~~(12)~~(11) To enter into such agreements or contracts with
17 agencies of the United States Government, agencies of the State of Arkansas,
18 other states, and registered land surveyors as he or she deems necessary or
19 desirable to properly plan and execute projects within the scope and purpose
20 of this subchapter; and

21 ~~(13)~~(12) To employ such surveyors and other professional and
22 nonprofessional assistants and to take other reasonable action as deemed
23 necessary to carry out the purposes of this subchapter.
