21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 28-48-102, concerning decedents' estates
24 letters of administration, is amended to add an additional subsection to read
25 as follows:

26 (d)(1)(A) Letters of administration are not necessary to empower the
27 person appointed to act for the estate.

28 (B) Letters of administration are for the purpose of
29 notifying third parties that the appointment of an administrator has been
30 made.

31 (2) The order appointing the administrator empowers the
32 administrator to act for the estate, and any act carried out under the
33 authority of the order is valid.
