## Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 6-16-104 TO ALLOW EDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENTS TO BE OFFERED IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-16-104 is amended to read as follows: 6-16-104. Basic language of instruction.
(a) The basic language of instruction in the public school branches in all the schools of the state, public and private, shall be the English language only.
(b) A language other than English may be used on state-mandated assessments that assess subject areas other than English language proficiency to separately evaluate a student's level of learning in the assessed areas.
(b) (c) It shall be the duty of the Commissioner of Education, the Director of the Department of Workforce Education, and city superintendents to see that the provisions of this section are carried out.
(c)(d) Any person violating the provisions of this section § 6-16104(a) shall be guilty of a violation and upon conviction shall be fined not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), payable into the general school fund of the county.
(d)(e) Each day this violation occurs shall be considered a separate
