19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-64-910(b) and (c), concerning the  
22 membership of the Task Force on Substance Abuse Treatment Services, is  
23 amended to read as follows:

24 (b) The task force shall be composed of the following members:

25 (1) ~~Three (3)~~ Five (5) senators appointed by the President Pro  
26 Tempore of the Senate; and

27 (2) ~~Three (3)~~ Four (4) members of the House of Representatives  
28 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

29 (c) The task force shall also have ~~twelve (12)~~ fourteen (14) advisory  
30 members to be appointed as follows:

31 (1) Six (6) members recommended by the Arkansas State Substance  
32 Abuse Treatment Providers Association;

33 (2) Two (2) members recommended by the Arkansas Association of  
34 Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors;

35 (3) One (1) member recommended by the Arkansas Substance Abuse  
36 Certification Board;



1                   (4) One (1) member recommended by the State Board of Examiners  
2 of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors;

3                   (5) One (1) member recommended by the Arkansas ~~Alcoholism~~ Alcohol  
4 and Drug Abuse Coordinating Council; ~~and~~

5                   (6) One (1) member recommended by the Bureau of Alcohol and Drug  
6 Abuse Prevention; and

7                   (7) Two (2) members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of  
8 the Senate.
