Subtitle TO AMEND THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT PROVISIONS AFFECTING THE RECORDS AND MEETINGS OF PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-19-103(6), concerning definitions used in the Freedom of Information Act, is amended to read as follows: (6)(A) "Public water system" means all facilities composing a system for the collection, treatment, and delivery of water to the general public, including, but not limited to, reservoirs, pipelines, reclamation facilities, processing facilities, and distribution facilities. (B) This subdivision (6) shall expire on July 1, 2007 July 1, 2009. SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 25-19-105(b)(16), concerning records that are not open to the public under the Freedom of Information Act, is amended to read as follows: (16)(A) Records, including analyses, investigations, studies,	1	State of Arkansas	A Bill

3	(i) Risk and vulnerability assessments;		
4	(ii) Plans and proposals for preventing and

9	disclosed might jeopardize or compromise efforts to secure and protect the

14	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 25-19-106(c)(6), concerning executive		
15	sessions under the Freedom of Information Act, is amended to read as follows:		
16	(6)(A) Subject to the provisions of subdivision (c)(4) of this		
17	section, any public agency may meet in executive session for the purpose of		
18	considering, evaluating, or discussing matters pertaining to public water		
19	system security as described in § 25-19-105(b)(16).		
20	(B) This subdivision (c)(6) shall expire on $\frac{\text{July 1, 2007}}{\text{July 1, 2007}}$		
21	July 1, 2009.

23	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
24	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that provisions in the Freedom of		
25	Information Act concerning records and meetings of public water systems will		
26	expire on July 1, 2007; that in order to protect the public, certain records		
27	of public water systems should continue to not be available to the public;		
28	that this act is necessary in order to ensure that public water systems are		
29	operated and managed safely and effectively; and that this act is immediately		
30	necessary in order to provide continuous protection to certain records of the		
31	public water systems. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this		
32	act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and		
33	safety shall become effective on July 1, 2007.
