- 12 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 8, Chapter 6, Subchapter 6 is amended 13 to add additional subchapters to read as follows:
- 14 <u>8-6-612. Landfill disposal fees to support a computer and electronic</u>
- 15 <u>equipment recycling program.</u>
- 16 (a)(1) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, there is
- 17 <u>imposed on each landfill permittee a landfill disposal fee of:</u>
- 18 <u>(A) Twenty-five cents (25¢) for each uncompacted cubic</u>
- 19 yard of solid waste received at the landfill; and
- 20 (B) Forty-five cents (45¢) for each compacted cubic yard
- 21 of solid waste received at the landfill.
- 22 (2) If a landfill permittee is required or chooses to operate on
- 23 <u>a weight basis, the landfill disposal fee shall be one dollar (\$1.00) for</u>
- 24 each one (1) ton of solid waste received at the landfill.
- 25 (b)(1) Except as provided in subsections (a) and (c) of this section,
- 26 for all solid waste generated and transported within the state but to be
- 27 disposed of outside the state, there is imposed on each solid waste
- 28 transporter a solid waste transportation fee of:
- 29 (A) Twenty-five cents (25¢) for each uncompacted cubic
- 30 yard of solid waste transported; and
- 31 (B) Forty-five cents (45¢) for each compacted cubic yard
- 32 of solid waste transported.
- 33 (2) If a solid waste transporter chooses to operate on a weight
- 34 basis, the solid waste transportation fee shall be one dollar (\$1.00) for

6	8-6-613. Computer and electronic equipment recycling program.			
7	(a) A program for the recycling of computer and electronic equipment			
8	is created.			
9	(b) The General Assembly finds that:			
10	(1) Computer and electronic equipment solid waste are among the			
11	fastest growing and most toxic segments of Arkansas' solid waste stream; and			
12	(2) There are recycling options to address this problem, and			
13	Arkansas solid waste districts and local governments and their delegated			
14	authorities and agents should develop solid waste management plans, programs,			
15	and facilities that integrate computer and electronic equipment recycling as			
16	a functional part of the solid waste management system.			
17	(c) The Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission may adopt			
18	reasonable rules necessary to implement an effective computer and electronic			
19	equipment recycling program.

22	The disposal fees authorized in § 8-6-612 shall not be collected until			
23	the Landfill Post-closure Trust Fund reaches twenty-five million dollars

27	25-34-111. Computer and electronic equipment landfill ban.			
28	Effective January 1, $\frac{2008}{2010}$ , the Arkansas Department of			
29	Environmental Quality Pollution Control and Ecology Commission may establish			
30	and implement rules <del>and regulations</del> banning the disposal of all computer and			
31	electronic equipment in Arkansas landfills.			
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
