6	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
7	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that many school districts in this		
8	state, in reliance on previous acts of the General Assembly and rules of the		
9	State Board of Education, have increased their salary schedules with national		
10	school lunch student funding; and if these school districts are not permitted		
11	to continue to use these funds for that purpose the school districts will		
12	face a serious financial threat. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
13	exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the		
14	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
15	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
16	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
17	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
18	bill; or		
19	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
20	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
