### Subtitle

12 AN ACT TO PROTECT CONFIDENTIAL  
13 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES  
14 INFORMATION.  
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 SECTION 1. To protect confidential Department of Health and Human  
22 Services records and information, Arkansas Code § 25-19-105(b) is amended by  
23 amending subdivisions (15) and (16) and adding an additional subdivision (17)  
24 to read as follows:

25 (15) Military service discharge records or DD Form 214, the  
26 Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty of the United States  
27 Department of Defense, filed with the county recorder as provided under § 14-  
28 2-102, for veterans discharged from service less than seventy (70) years from  
29 the current date; ~~and~~

30 (16)(A) Records, including analyses, investigations, studies,  
31 reports, recommendations, requests for proposals, drawings, diagrams,  
32 blueprints, and plans, containing information relating to security for any  
33 public water system.

34 (B) The records shall include:

35 (i) Risk and vulnerability assessments;

36 (ii) Plans and proposals for preventing and

2 (iii) Emergency response and recovery records;

3 (iv) Security plans and procedures; and

4 (v) Any other records containing information that if  
5 disclosed might jeopardize or compromise efforts to secure and protect the  
6 public water system.

7 (C) This subdivision (b)(16) shall expire on July 1,  
8 2007~~+~~; and

9 (17)(A) Records, including analyses, investigations, studies,  
10 reports, or recommendations, containing information relating to any  
11 Department of Health and Human Services risk or security assessment, known or  
12 suspected security vulnerability, or safeguard related to compliance with the  
13 Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act or protection of other  
14 confidential Department information.

15 (B) The records shall include:

16 (i) Risk and security assessments;

17 (ii) Plans and proposals for preventing and  
18 mitigating privacy and security risks;

19 (iii) Emergency response and recovery records;

20 (iv) Privacy and security plans and procedures; and

21 (v) Any other records containing information that if  
22 disclosed might jeopardize or compromise efforts to secure and protect  
23 personal health information or other protected department information.

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25 SECTION 2. This act expires on July 1, 2009.
