19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 21 is amended by adding a  
22 new subchapter to read as follows:

23 16-21-2801. Investigators.

24 (a)(1) The Prosecuting Attorney of the Twenty-third Judicial District  
25 shall be entitled to appoint and employ certified law enforcement officers as  
26 investigators for the prosecuting attorney's office if the prosecutor  
27 receives a federal grant or other funding therefore.

28 (2) County funds shall not be used to fund these positions  
29 unless approved by the quorum court.

30 (b)(1) All investigators authorized and so appointed shall have the  
31 authority to issue process, serve warrants, and shall possess all law  
32 enforcement officer powers.

33 (2) They shall be defined as public safety members under  
34 Arkansas law.

35 (3) If the investigators issue process or serve warrants, the  
36 prosecutor's office shall be entitled to receive the same fee as provided in



1 § 21-6-307, which shall be deposited into the hot check fee account.
