32	they develop more knowledge and skills in the use of data and instructional
33	strategies and should focus the training resources of the higher education
34	system toward development of the same needed skills for teachers; and

14	(2) Formative assessments;
15	(3) Teacher compensation issues;
16	(4) Higher education teacher preparation programs;
17	(5) School and district leadership development;
18	(6) Strategies for using instructional facilitators or coaches;

20	(7) Mentoring recommendations.
