SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
23 STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
24 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

26 That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
27 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
28 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Senators and
29 Representatives, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
30 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
31 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

33 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Section 2 of Amendment 73 to the Arkansas
34 Constitution is amended to read as follows:

35 (a)(1) The Arkansas House of Representatives shall consist of members
36 to be chosen every second year by the qualified electors of the several



1 counties.

2 (2)(A) No member of the Arkansas House of Representatives may
3 serve more than three such two year terms. This provision applies
4 through December 31, 2012.

5 (B) Beginning January 1, 2013, no member of the Arkansas
6 House of Representatives may serve more than five such two year terms.
