20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
21 STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
22 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
25 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
26 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Senators and
27 Representatives, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
28 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
29 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

SECTION 1. (a) The people have a right to hunt, fish, trap, and
32 harvest game, subject only to reasonable regulations prescribed by the
33 Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission.

(b) Consistent with the public trust to conserve birds, game, fish,
36 and wildlife, traditional methods may be used to take nonthreatened species
traditionally pursued.
