20	through the town of Dumas, Arkansas, causing injuries to scores of people and
21	damage to homes and businesses; and

23	WHEREAS, the tornado has wreaked havoc on Dumas, Arkansas, leaving
24	people without homes, jobs, and stability; and

26	WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas responded quickly with aid and
27	assistance to Dumas, Arkansas; and

29	WHEREAS, the town of Dumas and Desha County have expended significant
30	resources to deal with this natural disaster; and

32	WHEREAS, there are mobile homes sitting empty in Hope, Arkansas, that
33 24	could be used for the purpose of housing some of the displaced people in
34 35	Dumas, Arkansas; and
	LIVEDEAS the Department of Hemeland Security could facilitate deli-
