19 WHEREAS, for the first time in school history, the Greene County Tech  
20 Golden Eagles claimed a Boys' State Basketball Championship; and

22 WHEREAS, after last year's disappointing lost to Magnolia in the  
23 quarterfinals, the Golden Eagles were determined to avoid a repeat of their  
24 2006 state tournament experience, routing Arkadelphia 55-35 in the Class 5A  
25 championship game; and

27 WHEREAS, Greene County Tech's Skyler Bowlin was named the Jonesboro  
28 Sun/Crown Trophy - Athlete of the Week for the week of March 4 through March  
29 10 and Class 5A Boys' State Basketball Tournament Most Valuable Player,  
30 scoring eighteen (18) points, grabbing five (5) rebounds, dishing out three  
31 (3) assists, and nabbing two (2) steals in the championship game; and

33 WHEREAS, Greene County Tech Head Coach Scott Bowlin credited his  
34 team's 28-4 record and state championship to their hard work and  
35 selflessness; and

1           WHEREAS, the Summit Arena in Hot Springs, Arkansas, was painted green  
2 with Greene County Tech fans flocking to watch the team's first state title,  
3 a tribute to the school, its players, parents, and fans; and

6 Bowlin, Kirk Porter, Jason Church, Jeffery Blake, and David Mitchell; and

8           WHEREAS, in the words of a Greene County resident, "The entire town of

10 state championship. They are gentlemen on and off the court and great role  
11 models for the children of today that look up to them. Way to go, Eagles
