9 COMMENDING ARKANSAS FARMERS FOR THEIR VITAL  
10 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE SECURITY AND ECONOMIC WELL-  
11 BEING OF THE STATE AND THE NATION, AND FOR  
12 PRODUCING THE FOOD AND FIBER THAT IS ESSENTIAL TO  
13 THE HEALTH AND SECURITY OF THE CITIZENS OF THIS  
14 STATE AND PEOPLE THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.

17 COMMENDING ARKANSAS FARMERS FOR THEIR  
18 VITAL CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE SECURITY AND  
19 ECONOMIC WELL-BEING OF THE STATE AND THE

23 WHEREAS, Twenty-five percent (25%) of Arkansas' economy is based on  
24 food, fiber, and forestry; and

25  
26 WHEREAS, Two-thirds (2/3) of Arkansas' counties rely heavily on farming  
27 and forestry as their industrial base; and

28  
29 WHEREAS, Agriculture and related activities and industries employ one  
30 (1) in every five (5) Arkansans; and

31  
32 WHEREAS, Agricultural pursuits in this state generate a value in excess  
33 of fifteen billion dollars (\$15,000,000,000) annually which contributes to  
34 Arkansas' stable and well-balanced economy; and

36 WHEREAS, Farmers, ranchers, and foresters provide the bulk of the



1 state's wildlife habitat, practice sound environmental stewardship, and  
2 supply community leadership throughout rural Arkansas; and

4 WHEREAS, The agricultural community contributes a substantial portion  
5 of the revenues which finance state and local services to all this state's  
6 citizens; and

7  
8 WHEREAS, Arkansas farmers, ranchers, and foresters are deserving of  
9 public commendation and appreciation,

11 NOW THEREFORE,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
13 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 THAT the Senate expresses sincere appreciation to Arkansas farmers for  
16 their outstanding contributions to the economy of the state and nation and to  
17 the well-being of the people and commends them for their dedication to the  
18 wise utilization of our resources.
