23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF	THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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25	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - SUPPLEMENT	AL. There is hereby appropriated,	to
26	the Arkansas House of Representatives, to be payable from the Constitutional		
27	Officers Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas		
28	House of Representatives which shall be supplemental and in addition to those		
29	funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 2 of 2007 and Section 11 of Act 308 of		
30	2007, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the sum		sum
31	of	\$50,0	00.

33	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS	. Disbursement of funds authoriz	ed
34	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds		
35	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the		
36	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 3 4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 6 7 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 8 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 9 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 10 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 11 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 12 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 13 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 14 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 15 16 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 17 Assembly, meeting in extraordinary session, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Arkansas House of Representatives 18 are, due to the call of the Governor for convening of an extraordinary 19 20 session, insufficient for the Arkansas House of Representatives to continue 21 to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act 22 will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas House of Representatives 23 to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act 24 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared 25 26 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the 27 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and 28 after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of 29 30 the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become 31 32 effective on the date the last house overrides the veto. 33 34 35

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
