1 (a) Every municipality in the State of Arkansas is authorized by the 2 passage of a municipal ordinance to adopt by reference technical codes, 3 regulations, or standards, without setting forth the provisions of the code 4 or parts thereof, if three (3) copies of the code, or the pertinent parts 5 thereof, and any related documents are filed <u>either electronically or by hard</u> 6 <u>copy</u> in the office of the clerk of the municipality for inspection and view 7 by the public prior to before the passage of the ordinance.

8 (b) The term "technical codes" shall include any building, zoning, 9 health, electrical, or plumbing codes, and the term "regulations" shall 10 include any criminal code of the State of Arkansas.

(c) It shall be <u>is</u> the duty of the municipality to give a notice to the public, by publication in a paper of general circulation within the municipality, stating that copies of the code, or the pertinent parts thereof, and the related documents are open to public examination <u>either</u> <u>electronically or by hard copy prior to before</u> the passage of the ordinance adopting the code.
