17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-132(b), concerning prohibiting
20 registered sex offenders from entering upon school campuses, is amended to
21 read as follows:

22 (b) It is unlawful for a sex offender who is required to register
23 under the Sex Offender Registration Act of 1997, § 12-12-901 et seq., and
24 who has been assessed as a Level 2, Level 3, or Level 4 offender to knowingly
25 enter upon the campus of a public school.

27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-14-132(c)(1), concerning an exemption for
28 minor students who are registered sex offenders from the prohibition on
29 entering school campuses, is amended to read as follows:

30 (1) Is a ~~minor~~ juvenile as defined by § 9-27-303, and is a student;
