19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-16-102(c), concerning the penalty range
22 for the crime of voyeurism, is amended to read as follows:

23 (c)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section, a
24 violation of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

25 ~~(c) (1) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section, a~~
26 ~~violation of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.~~

27 ~~(2) A violation of this section is a Class D felony if:~~

28 ~~(A) A victim is under seventeen (17) years of age; and~~

29 ~~(B) The person who commits the offense holds a position of~~
30 ~~trust or authority over the victim.~~

31 (c)(1) A violation of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

32 (2) However, a violation of this section is a Class D felony if
33 the person committing the act is eighteen (18) years of age or older at the
34 time he or she commits the offense.
