1 STATEMENT OF BOLL WEEVIL ERADICATION DEBT. The Arkansas Department of 2 Agriculture - Plant Board shall annually provide each cotton producer in Arkansas a statement of the amount of obligated and projected debt owed for 3 4 the Boll Weevil Eradication Program. 5 6 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING 8 TRANSFER. On the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and 9 the Auditor of the State the sum of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000), or 10 11 so much thereof as is available, from the un-obligated balances in the General Improvement Fund to the Plant Board Fund to provide funds for the 12 purpose of reducing the current long term debt associated with the 13 implementation of the Arkansas Boll Weevil Eradication Program as 14 15 appropriated herein. 16 Any unexpended balance of moneys remaining in the Plant Board Fund at the 17 end of a fiscal year that were transferred due to the provisions of this section shall remain in the Plant Board Fund and be made available for the 18 same purpose during the next fiscal year. 19 20 21 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 24 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 30 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 31 32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or		
2	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
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4	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
5	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
6	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
7	effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is		
8	essential for Boll Weevil Eradication for the benefit of all cotton produces		
9	in the Sate of Arkansas, and that in the event of an extension of the Regula		
10	Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its		
11	passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper		
12	administration and provision of the Boll Weevil Eradication Program.		
13	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being		
14	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and		
15	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its		
16	passage and approval.		
17	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become		
18	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor		
19	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
20	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides		
21	the veto.
