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1 STATEMENT OF BOLL WEEVIL ERADICATION DEBT. The Arkansas Department of 2 Agriculture - Plant Board shall annually provide each cotton producer in Arkansas a statement of the amount of obligated and projected debt owed for 3 4 the Boll Weevil Eradication Program. 5 6 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING 8 TRANSFER. On the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and 9 the Auditor of the State the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000), or so 10 11 much thereof as is available, from the un-obligated balances in the General Improvement Fund to the Plant Board Fund to provide funds for the purpose of 12 13 reducing the current long term debt associated with the implementation of the Arkansas Boll Weevil Eradication Program as appropriated herein. 14 15 Any unexpended balance of moneys remaining in the Plant Board Fund at the 16 end of a fiscal year that were transferred due to the provisions of this 17 section shall remain in the Plant Board Fund and be made available for the same purpose during the next fiscal year. 18 19 20 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 21 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 22 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 23 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 29 30 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 31 32 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 33 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 34 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 36 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

1	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
4	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
5	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
6	effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is		
7	essential for Boll Weevil Eradication for the benefit of all cotton producers		
8	in the Sate of Arkansas, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular		
9	Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its		
10	passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper		
11	administration and provision of the Boll Weevil Eradication Program.		
12	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being		
13	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and		
14	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its		
15	passage and approval.		
16	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become		
17	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor		
18	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
19	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides		
20	the veto.
