## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO AMEND DOMESTIC BATTERING IN THE FIRST  
11 AND SECOND DEGREE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

13 AN ACT TO AMEND DOMESTIC BATTERING IN  
14 THE FIRST AND SECOND DEGREE.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-26-303(a), concerning the offense of  
21 domestic battering in the first degree, is amended to read as follows:  
22

23 (a) A person commits domestic battering in the first degree if:

24 (1) With the purpose of causing serious physical injury to a  
25 family or household member, the person causes serious physical injury to a  
26 family or household member by means of a deadly weapon;

27 (2) With the purpose of seriously and permanently disfiguring a  
28 family or household member or of destroying, amputating, or permanently  
29 disabling a member or organ of a family or household member's body, the  
30 person causes such an injury to a family or household member;

31 (3) The person causes serious physical injury to a family or  
32 household member under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the  
33 value of human life; ~~or~~

34 (4) The person knowingly causes serious physical injury to a  
35 family or household member he or she knows to be sixty (60) years of age or  
36 older or twelve (12) years of age or younger; or



1           ~~(4)~~(5) He or she commits any act of domestic battering as  
2 defined in subdivisions (a)(1) – (3) of this section or § 5-26-304 or § 5-26-  
3 305 and, for conduct that occurred within the ten (10) years preceding the  
4 commission of the current offense, he or she has on two (2) previous  
5 occasions been convicted of any act of battery against a family or household  
6 member as defined by the laws of this state or by the equivalent laws of any  
7 other state or foreign jurisdiction.

9           SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-26-304(a), concerning the offense of  
10 domestic battering in the second degree, is amended to read as follows:

12           (a) A person commits domestic battering in the second degree if:

13                   (1) With the purpose of causing physical injury to a family or  
14 household member, the person causes serious physical injury to a family or  
15 household member;

16                   (2) With the purpose of causing physical injury to a family or  
17 household member, the person causes physical injury to a family or household  
18 member by means of a deadly weapon; ~~or~~

19                   (3) The person recklessly causes serious physical injury to a  
20 family or household member by means of a deadly weapon; or

21                   (4) The person knowingly causes physical injury to a family or  
22 household member he or she knows to be sixty (60) years of age or older or  
23 twelve (12) years of age or younger.
