19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-8-701(a), concerning persons required to  
22 file a statement of financial interest, is amended to read as follows:

23 (a) The following persons shall file a written statement of financial  
24 interest:

- 25 (1) A public official, as defined in § 21-8-402(17);  
26 (2) A candidate for elective office;  
27 (3) A district judge or city attorney, whether elected or  
28 appointed;  
29 (4) Any agency head, department director, or division director  
30 of state government;

31 (5)(A) Any public appointee to any state board or commission  
32 that is authorized or charged by law with the exercise of regulatory  
33 authority or is authorized to receive or disburse state or federal funds.

34 (B) A public appointee to a state board or commission that  
35 is not charged by law with the exercise of regulatory authority and that  
36 receives or disburses state or federal funds only in the form of mileage



1 reimbursement for members attending meetings of the board or commission shall  
2 not be required to file a written statement of financial interest;

3 (6) All persons who are elected members of a school board or who  
4 are candidates for a position on a school board;

5 (7) All public and charter school superintendents;

6 (8) Executive directors of education service cooperatives; and

7 (9) Any person appointed to one (1) of the following types of  
8 regional, municipal, or county boards or commissions:

9 (A) A planning board or commission;

10 (B) An airport board or commission;

11 (C) A water or sewer board or commission;

12 (D) A utility board or commission; ~~or~~

13 (E) A civil service commission; or

14 (F) A board of election commissioners.
